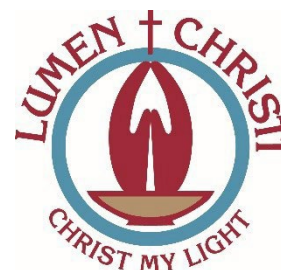

## STUDENT UNIFORM AND PRESENTATION GUIDELINE

### 1. Purpose

The purpose of this Student Uniform and Presentation Guideline is to inform the College community of the uniform and presentation requirements and the expectations of its wear by students.

Full support by parents and students of the College Uniform and Presentation Guideline is required.

### 2. Scope

Students have a summer uniform and a winter uniform. The summer uniform is worn during Terms 1 and 4 and the winter uniform is worn during Terms 2 and 3.

As the College cannot legislate for every contingency, the Deputy Principal Mission, under the direction of the Principal, exercises final judgement regarding the appropriateness of an individual student's presentation.

### 3. Definitions

Parents - includes parents, guardians and caregivers.

### 4. Guidelines

Students are required to arrive at and depart from school in their full college uniform. If it becomes necessary on occasion for a student to wear alternative items, the first choice should always be the alternative formal uniform (summer or winter) and parents must inform the College in writing of the need for this uniform variation. If this is not possible the College sports uniform may be worn.

### Summer Uniform

## Winter Uniform

## Term 1-4

Black 'leather' polished shoes with black stitching and laces or velcro strap (low-heeled less than 3cm)	College cap or college bucket hat must be worn throughout: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Terms 1 and 4 during breaks one and two, when in non-shaded parts of the campus e.g., the College oval</li> <li>• During Physical Education lessons all year</li> </ul>	On Seminar days, students wear the: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>College House shirt</li> <li>College sport shorts [Terms 1 – 4]</li> <li>College tracksuit [Terms 2 – 3]</li> </ul> <p><i>If students participate in Physical Education or Outdoor Education on these days, they must change into their college sports shirt for this lesson/activity</i></p>

Sports Uniform	Sports Footwear	Outdoor Education
College tracksuit	Appropriate running shoes that are 'non-marking' (casual sneakers, dress sneakers, skate shoes, volleys or similar are not permitted)	Students studying Outdoor Education are required to wear the College rashie shirt during practical water based lessons

**Please Note** Students must not wear the College jumper with their sports uniform. It is required students wear the College hat for all outdoor activities.

## Other Uniform Information

### College Backpack and College Sports Bag

The College backpack or college sports bag is a compulsory item of uniform.

### Safety Uniform

Safety glasses and an apron are compulsory for all Manual Arts classes.

### Presentation

Jewellery	Earrings
One of each of the following jewellery items is permitted in plain gold or silver colour: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ring</li><li>• Bracelet</li><li>• Chain</li><li>• Watch</li></ul>	One or two pairs of small, plain studs or small sleepers to be worn in lower ear lobes in normal size ear piercings. A maximum of two earrings in each lower ear lobe is permitted. Any other items of jewellery or piercings are not permitted.

Hair	General Presentation
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Hairstyles should not be extreme including having significant variations in length</li><li>• Hair must be in one natural tone. Brightly coloured hair or extreme highlights are not permitted</li><li>• If hair is short, it must be neat and off the face</li><li>• Hair longer than the bottom of the collar must be tied back and secured with a black elastic hair accessory.</li><li>• Hair accessories, including beads in braids must be black and non-obtrusive.</li><li>• A cut below a number one is not permitted</li><li>• Students must be clean shaven</li><li>• Sideburns must not be longer than the bottom of the ear</li></ul>	The following are general presentation requirements: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Makeup, other than a light tinted foundation, is not to be worn to school</li><li>• Coloured nail varnish is not to be worn to school, false nails are not permitted</li><li>• Tee shirts worn under clothing must not be visible</li><li>• The top button of the shirt must be fastened when wearing the College tie</li><li>• Students with tattoos and/or body art must cover the tattoo or body art.</li></ul>
