Applications for 2021 Music Scholarships are now open!

Applications close Friday, 11 September, 2020.

Auditions will take place week commencing Monday, 21 September, 2020.

Lumen Christi College is committed to the development of Music Excellence. As such, the College is introducing the opportunity to apply for Music Scholarships to prospective and currently enrolled Year 7 students commencing at the College in 2021.

Applications are now open for 2021 Music Scholarships. Auditions will take place in the week commencing Monday, 21 September 2020. Please see below for further details on the audition process and application requirements.

In addition to these Music Scholarships, the College may offer *Music Prizes* for Lumen Christi College students. More information on Music Prizes will be made available on our website in the near future.

Description:

The College offers two full Music Scholarships to Year 7 students commencing at the College in 2021. Music Scholarships are awarded based on musical excellence and talent. Scholarships are for a three-year term, covering music tuition for Years 7-9. This may be extended to include future years at the College pending a review at the end of Year 9.

Music Scholarships provide:

- 100 per cent of music tuition which entitles the recipient to 32 x 30-minute individual instrument or vocal lessons per school year
- Free instrument hire (if applicable) on one instrument for the duration of the Scholarship
- The College reserves the right to offer the preferred candidates a Music scholarship on an instrument which is different to the instrument they are currently learning, based on the needs of the Music Department

Music Scholarship recipients are required to:

- Make a leading contribution to music at the College
- Maintain a high level of achievement on their chosen instrument
- Enrol in Specialist Music classes for the duration of the Scholarship
- Participate in at least two College ensembles for the duration of the Scholarship
- Take part in an annual review of progress to ensure satisfactory achievement is taking place



How to apply:

- Candidates must complete the [Year 7-9 Music Scholarship 2021 Application & Letter of Recommendation Form](#) by no later than **Friday, 11 September 2020**
- Upon receipt of application, the College Music Administrator will contact families by phone regarding audition details and to discuss any queries

Music Scholarship audition candidates are required to:

- Audition on any woodwind, brass or percussion instrument (including piano), or voice. A successful recipient on piano or voice may continue to learn piano or voice as their principal instrument, but will also be highly encouraged to learn a second instrument to contribute to instrumental ensembles at the College
- Prepare and perform two contrasting pieces on their principal instrument at a minimum Grade 3 AMEB standard (or equivalent)
- Prepare and perform one piece at a minimum Grade 3 AMEB standard (or equivalent) if applicable
- Provide their own Accompanist for audition pieces requiring accompaniment, or make arrangements with our College Accompanist through our College Music Administrator. Fees will be charged at College Accompanist rates of \$15 per 15 minutes. Candidates are also welcome to perform audition pieces with backing tracks where practical
- Undertake an aural test at Grade 3 AMEB level, sight reading at Grade 3 AMEB level and a short informal interview as part of the Music Scholarship audition process
