## Uniform and Presentation

### Introduction:

Lumen Christi College students wear the College uniform as a badge of pride which creates the College identity.

Students at the College have a summer uniform and a winter uniform. The summer uniform is worn during Terms 1 and 4 and the winter uniform is worn during Terms 2 and 3.

### Rationale:

Lumen Christi College students wear the College uniform to:

- Develop a sense of student unity and loyalty to the College
- Minimise differences resulting from socio-economic background
- De-emphasise differences in appearance and to focus on the real purpose of schooling – the development of an individuality of intellect, imagination and personality

### Definitions:

'Uniform' is distinctive clothing worn by members belonging to the same group or organisation, e.g. school or College.

'Parents' encompasses parents, guardians, caregivers.

### Principles:

As the College cannot legislate for every contingency, the Assistant Deputy Principal Mission, under the direction of the Principal, reserves the right of final balanced judgement with regard to the students' well-being, presentation and discipline as published and reflected in the enrolment agreement which students and parents sign upon admission to the College.

Full support by parents and students of the College Uniform and Presentation Policy is essential for ongoing enrolment at Lumen Christi College.

### Procedures:

Students are required to arrive at school, and depart from school in their full College uniform. If it becomes necessary on any one day for a student to wear a substitute College uniform, parents are requested to inform the College in writing.

### Summer Uniform [Terms 1 and 4]

## Other Uniform Information

### College Back Pack and College Sports Bag

The College Backpack and the College Sports Bag are compulsory items of the College uniform.

- The College Sports Bag is for sports clothes only, and is not a substitute for the College Back Pack
- The College Back Pack and College Sports Bag are to be kept in students' lockers, except when taking the College Sports Bag to and from sport

### Safety Uniform

- Safety glasses and apron are required for all Manual Arts classes

### House Uniform

- On timetabled Seminar Days students, at the discretion of the Principal, wear the College House shirt with their College sport shorts or their College tracksuit – dependent on the term.

## Presentation

### Jewellery

Jewellery is to be gold or silver. One each of the following jewellery items is permitted:

- Ring
- Bracelet
- Chain
- Watch

### Earrings

- One or two pairs of small, plain studs or small sleepers (silver or gold) to be worn in lower ear lobes in normal size ear piercings

Any other items of jewellery, including extra ear piercings, tongue piercings, nose studs, and eyebrow rings/rods or any other visible piercings, are not permitted.

### Hair

- Hairstyles should not attract undue attention or be extreme
- Hair must be in one natural tone
- Brightly coloured hair or extreme highlights are not permitted
- Individual clumps, patches of colour or streaks in the hair are not permitted
- If hair is short it should be neat, clean and off the face, particularly out of eyes
- Hair longer than the bottom of the collar must be tied back and secured with a black elastic hair accessory
- A cut below a number two is not permitted
- Sideburns must not be any lower than the bottom of the ear
- Students must be clean shaven
- Students will be instructed to correct hair colouring or hair styles that are deemed not fitting with the Uniform and Presentation Policy

## General Presentation

The following are general presentation requirements:

- Makeup, other than a light tinted foundation, is not to be worn to school
- Coloured nail varnish is not to be worn to school.
- Skirts are not to be rolled
- Trousers and shorts are not to be worn on the hip
- Tee shirts that hang down longer than the sleeve of the shirt or dress, or are visible around the neckline are not permitted
- Shoes are to be laced correctly and feet are to be fully enclosed in the shoe
- The top button of the shirt must be done up when wearing the College Tie

Students with tattoos and/or body art will be expected to cover the tattoo or body art either with clothing, appropriate bandaging or cosmetically
