Dear Parents and Caregivers

I refer to previous correspondence at the commencement of Term 2 where I advised that, as per current government regulated Covid-19 restrictions, parents and caregivers are not permitted to enter the College grounds, with the exception of the carparks when dropping off or picking up their child. Parents and caregivers must remain in their car.

Currently, these restrictions are still in place until the end of Week 6 (Friday, 5 June).

I therefore respectfully request that, for the safety of our students and staff, parents and caregivers do not come to Student Services, the Uniform Shop or other areas within the College.

Whilst these restrictions are current, please remain in your car when attending the College and call Student Services on 9394 9326 for student related issues, the Perm-a-Pleat Uniform Shop on 9394 9349 for uniform enquiries, or the College Reception on 9394 9300 for other matters.

Parents collecting a child from Student Services are asked to park in the designated Student Services parking bays at Entrance 2 (G Centre). This makes you clearly visible to the Student Services officer. Please call Student Services (9394 9326), and your child will be dismissed to meet you at your car in view of the Student Services officer, or the Student Services officer will come out to your car if necessary, e.g. should you be bringing in an item to the College for your child.
